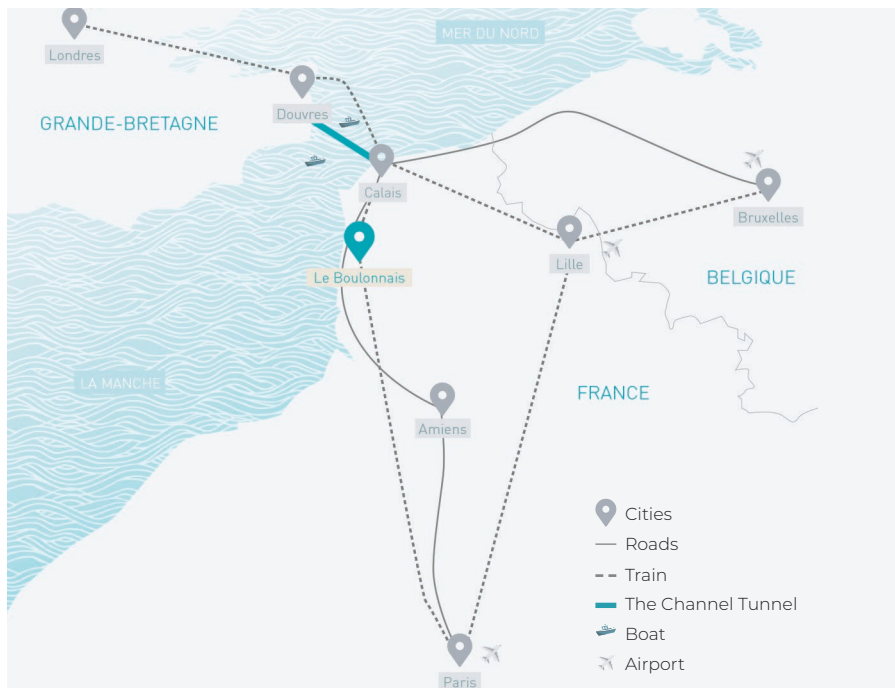

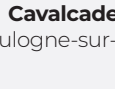

Welcoming and dynamic, Boulogne-sur-Mer promotes the art of living, with its markets on Wednesday and Saturday mornings (place Dalton) and the Sunday morning fish stalls at Quai Gambetta...

This town within the city is incredible when observed from the outside !

Biggest French fishing port with a fleet of nearly 150 vessels, the port of Boulogne-sur-Mer is a hive of activity with boats returning from sea with produce for the factories to process.

On average, 90 tonnes of fish are landed every day in the port of Boulogne. 70 species are sold at auction throughout the year. From fishing to processing, from marketing to distribution, from training to research and development...

Boulogne-sur-Mer has all the facilities of the sector.

To understand and enjoy what built the reputation of these merry fishermen, head for the port at the crack of dawn to buy freshly-landed fish from the catch of the day ! A great way to immerse yourself in the traditions of Boulogne.

A visit of the National Sea Centre, Nausicaá, for a beautiful underwater experience of our seas and oceans.

The little gem of Saint-Jean Bay

Impossible not to succumb to the charm of this small seaside resort where a hundred or so beautiful Belle Epoque villas display their audacity. Nestled in the heart of Saint-Jean Bay, Wimereux enjoys a very special atmosphere.

One of the most beautiful seawalls of the Opal Coast, with its picturesque beach huts, invites you to enjoy the delights of sea bathing. In the city centre, Rue Carnot is lined with boutiques selling handmade delicacies and decorative items, as well as clothes shops and art galleries. For a taste of local produce, try the markets : on Tuesday and Friday mornings during high season at rue Pierre-André Wimet and in low season at place Albert 1st (opposite the town hall).. Wimereux is also an exceptional natural setting which is ideal for walking, between the dunes of Slack in the north and Pointe aux Oies in the south...

LE PORTEL

Naturally Welcoming

This is an old fishing port of character which appeals to families and nature lovers. Sheltered by the harbour of Boulogne-sur-Mer, the resort has a wonderful treasure : its 1.5 km beach ! There is plenty of room here for children and adults to run about and enjoy water sports or activities on the beach. As well as seaside fun, Le Portel also boasts a number of parks and gardens for walkers to enjoy. Overlooking the sea, the “La Falaise” Park alone offers 27 hectares in which to relax between its lakes and recreational areas. Feast your eyes on a breathtaking view over the beach from the top of Mont de Couppes. In the distance, you can see the Heurt Fort, the Alprech lighthouse and fort, a historic site whose remains can be explored with the Tourist Information Office.

Flobarts

As an authentic symbol of the Opal Coast, the Flobart is still the star of the beach at Le Portel. These small flat-bottomed boats have a pointed bow and are square at the stern (!). They still go out to sea occasionally to fish for sole, plaice, cod, bass, mackerel, crab and even

lobster ! A unique display, as they have to be towed on the beach by tractors. You can see them near the “Barsiers Portelois” boat park (private club). The Flobart’s particularity is that runs aground directly on the beach. It can carry up to 3 adults for a rod-fishing session.



Land of Carnival

For three days ending on Shrove Tuesday, the whole town of Le Portel celebrates its carnival. Costumed groups, decorated, humorous floats and marching bands... Enjoy a unique experience with family or friends !

Program:

- **Saturday** : “Avant-Bande” (start of carnival) and Batiss awakening
- **Sunday** : Colourful parade and ball.
- **Monday** : Time for “pec-pec” (a gathering of carnival-goers wearing fisherman’s oilskins) and ball.
- **Tuesday** : bonfire with the burning of a giant doll.

Quilles en l'air



Equihen-Plage is also a resort of curiosities... The resort with "quilles en l'air" (literally, "keels in the air"!)

At the beginning of the 20th century, Equihen-Plage was well-known in the area for boats running aground. Fishing boats were stranded on the beach with every tide change. Their wooden hulls were quickly worn down by frequent contact with the sand. The poorest families salvaged them to make shelters. "Nothing is lost, everything is transformed" as Lavoisier said... Hence, the boat hulls were installed on the hillside on the heights of the village. Painted with tar, from a distance they looked like mussels clinging to rocks on the beach.

Until the Second World War, "Quilles en l'Air" was an authentic district but successive bombardments destroyed this incredible maritime heritage. Several

years ago, the village revisited this tradition by building several "quilles en l'air" dwellings, mod cons included, on the municipal campsite. They are available to rent for a night, weekend or weekend and are popular with holidaymakers who can enjoy the breathtaking view over the coast. Ideal for a holiday with a difference.

FISHING

Fishing and water sports abound in the Boulonnais ! Here are some recommendations to help you have a great time.

Bathing Guide

- **Green flag:** bathing allowed
- **Yellow flag:** bathing allowed but dangerous
- **Red flag:** bathing prohibited
- **Purple flag:** bathing prohibited (polluted water)
- Bathing area
- Area reserved for water sports

Consult the tide times before any practice

(available on the home page of boulonnaisautop.com)

Fishing : conditions and regulations

Possible throughout the year, day and night, along the coast. Comply with instructions concerning military zones, ports or unfit areas, as well as regulations aimed seabed preservation, and municipal by-laws (e.g., minimum size of fish caught). It is forbidden to sell the catch.



Shore Fishing & Beach Foraging

Anyone can use a hand-held fishing line, gather crustaceans or shellfish by hand, or go hook and line fishing (local restrictions may apply for safety reasons or to preserve species). Fishing with nets or other authorised devices in the North Sea, the English Channel or the Atlantic Ocean requires the prior permission of local maritime authorities. This does not apply to hand-held fishing nets or shrimp nets, fishing baskets or creels, for which no formalities are necessary.

WATER SPORTS

Windsurfing / Kitesurfing

- Beware of offshore winds which can make it difficult to return to the beach
- Wear a wetsuit to protect against the cold
- Use the buoyed channels to leave the shore
- Do not venture more than one nautical mile from the coast
- Never leave your board
- For kite surfing, wear a helmet and buoyancy jacket and make sure you are equipped with a safety release system allowing you to reduce traction on the kite without losing it.

Sailing and Kayaking

- Check the weather before any excursion
- Wear your life jacket
- Protect yourself against the cold
- Remember your safety equipment
- Respect the dedicated channels when moving away from the shore
- In the event of a problem, do not leave your boat
- Sea Kayaking : beware of the current which is sometimes very strong. Find out beforehand.

Personal Water Craft

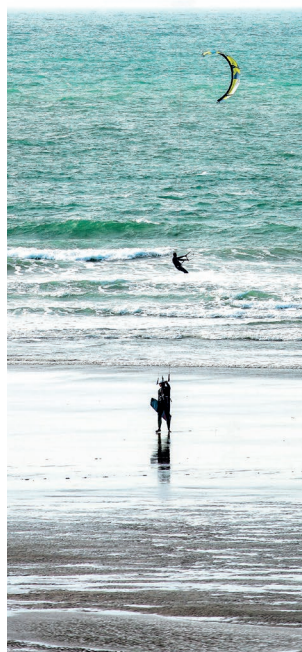
- Remember, a sea permit is mandatory, even for a rental
- The authorised area is between 300 metres and 1 to 2 nautical miles from the shore
- Respect the dedicated channels when moving away from the shore
- It is mandatory to wear a brightly-coloured life jacket.
- Use your personal water craft only by day
- The speed limit is generally 5 knots within 300 metres of the shore
- Respect navigation rules and rights of way.

Surfing

- Be careful of bathers
- Check that your leash is in good condition
- Wear a wetsuit to protect against the cold.

The Harbour and the Port circuit: During this visit, the Captain will tell you all about the various aspects of a seaman's life, fishing and the everyday life of the port. Duration: 1 hour round trip.

The Pointe aux Oies circuit: Located north of Wimereux you can admire the cliffs from the sea, the Fort d'Ambleteuse and enjoy the marine fauna with the seals and calves. Duration: 1 hour 30 round trip.

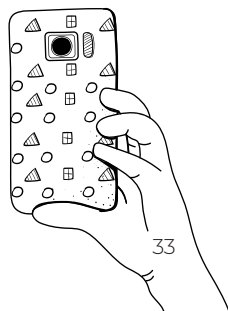

FORESTS

«The best thing about forests is that they evolve and are never the same. Even if we know the path by heart, the colours, the light, the smells, everything is always different, and it always ends up marvelling us! »

In the Boulonnais region, there are 3 forests with very distinct identities: the state-owned forest of Boulogne-sur-Mer, the forest of Ecault, the state-owned forest of Hadelot... Not forgetting the Mont Saint-Frieux, a unique dune jewel in the North of France.

• Boulogne forest

The national forest of Boulogne-sur-Mer is the largest forest in the département. Covering 2018 hectares (about 4000 acres), it is full of wildlife with lots of wildflower types and happy bird song to accompany your visit... The woodlands are home to two protected bird species, the Saint-Martin Harrier and the Honey Buzzard. It is not uncommon to have to cross a small stream, a tributary of Wimereux or the Liane, to continue your walk or ride. And don't forget the colours that transform the forest decor each season. Autumn amazes with its shades of red and orange, while spring has a panoply of beautiful changing atmospheres, with bluebells dappled in the sunny blue undergrowth.



• Ecault dunes and forest

Behind the beautiful beaches that characterize the Boulogne country you'll find lots of delights popular with local walkers. The forest of Ecault is one of these. Despite its smaller size (315 hectares), the forest of Ecault is an attraction for walkers who can enjoy ten different signposted trails through the woodland, adapted for beginners, families and seasoned hikers alike. What we like most when crisscrossing the area, is the different environments, which transform the scenery as you walk. Your senses will be invaded by the rich smell of maritime pines and other tree species, mingled with the birdsong and splashes of wildflowers competing in colour and display. Alternating between the almost monastic atmosphere of the great forests, and the bucolic ambience of the woodland graves, you might cross a small stream before coming up against the white sand dunes behind the beach.

• Hardelot forest

By the sea, in the pretty seaside village of Hardelot, the forest of Hardelot enchants visitors with its great diversity of environments and plant life. It plays a central role in the environment of the region. It is also and above all, an enchanting place that offers visitors a real opportunity to unwind! A trip through the forest of Hardelot is to discover a natural environment in all its splendor. It's like being in a fabulous art gallery, where you stand before one landscape after another, except that here, museum is life size!



• Le Mont Saint-Frieux

Discover a natural and protected site between land and sea with dunes, forest, and idyllic panoramas. The dunes of Mont Saint-Frieux are one of the jewels of the Boulonnais coastline. The dune has joined a chalk mountain to give one of the Opal Coast's most unusual and exotic places. Put on your walking or hiking boots and climb to the highest point of the dune (152m), offering a spectacular panorama of the English Channel and coasts. Covering nearly 1500 hectares and away from all buildings and roads, nothing disturbs the department's largest natural dune site and makes it a totally preserved natural area.

HIKING

A dozen signposted itineraries will take you on a voyage through these charming unspoiled regions. You can opt for short family outings or long escapes: there is something for every taste and desire. Guess the English coasts from the top of a cliff or a dune, breathe deeply in the forest, and listen to the birds singing. Be amazed by the small and significant heritage of our towns, immerse yourself in the simplicity of authentic villages, stroll in the heart of the bocage, walk on the great expanses of sand... The variety of routes is striking. Non-exhaustive list of hikes in the Boulonnais area : Sentier de la Pierre de Baincthun, Circuit du Patrimoine in Boulogne-sur-Mer, Sentier du Marais in Condette, Sentier du Rieu de Cat in Le Portel, Sentier de la Baie Saint-Jean in Wimereux, Sentier du Parcours Imperial in Wimille, Sentier du Pre Catalan in Hardelot Sentier de la Glaisiere in Nesles, Boucle de la Pomme d'Or in Mont Saint-Frieux...

JARDINS DE NAUSICAÁ

Just opposite the largest aquarium, relax in the garden where you will find a playground and mini-golf. Young and old alike will find their happiness in the gardens restored with the opening of the great Nausicaá. Since this summer, a scenic walk is accessible from the gardens in front of Ifremer and a path that starts next to the miniature golf course or in front of Nausicaá. An opportunity to discover a new seaside promenade and to extend this walk to the red lighthouse. **Boulevard Sainte-Beuve.**

JARDIN DES TINTELLERIES

A lovely place for a walk, the Jardin des Tintelleries is popular with the locals. Located near Boulogne-Tintelleries station, it has existed for more than 100 years. Don't miss the 19th century gate, the only remnant of the original garden, which was destroyed during the Second World War. **Rue Dutertre.**



BERGES DE LA LIANE

The banks of the River Liane are a popular walking spot for families and a paradise for fitness fanatics. With a walking trail covering over five kilometers, joggers and runners can have fun hitting the pavement. Kids' play areas, skatepark for teens, relaxation area for bookworms: there's everything you need to take time out in the heart of the city. **Boulevard Diderot.**



JARDIN BUCCIALI

On the heights of Boulogne-sur-Mer, the Jardin Bucciali is a flowery and wooded environment. Its paths and stone staircases offer a unique view over the rooftops of the town. **Vallon Notre-Dame.**





SQUARE MARIETTE PACHA

At the foot of the Notre-Dame Basilica, the old priory garden has been opened to the public and is a small oasis of greenery, much appreciated by visitors to the building and its amazing crypt. It is home to plants and trees that were useful in the everyday life of the Middle Ages - there are few flowers, but many vegetables, medicinal plants, aromatics and spices. A curiosity in a category of its own! **Boulevard Auguste.**



JARDIN ET PROMENADE DES REMPARTS

This tree, a panchronic species, survived the bombing of Hiroshima when all other life around it had been destroyed. **Rue Guyale.**



BOIS FARJON

In the Montplaisir district, the Farjon wood is the favourite place for lovers of pétanque with its boulodrome. Young and old alike can now also climb trees with the new adventure course Acro'Liane. Situated on the heights of Capecure, the wood is a real place of relaxation and nature in the heart of the Boulonnais area. **Boulevard Montesquieu.**



JARDIN ÉPHÉMÈRE

From the end of June to mid-October, Place Godefroy de Bouillon is transformed into an ephemeral garden and throws your senses into turmoil. André Le Nôtre, Jérôme Bosch, the 7 deadly sins, La Fontaine's fables... Each year, the experience is renewed around a different theme! **Place de la Mairie.**

Condette

LE MARAIS

Located at the foot of the castle of Hardelot in Condette, the marsh immerses you in the heart of this regional nature reserve. the marsh of Condette is a favorite family location for the people of Boulogne and a popular place for sporting events. Try and experience it at different times of day as the animals and plants will offer you a different spectacle at every visit. **Avenue Charlemagne.**





Équihen-Plage

PARC DES HURES

Perfect for lovers of the outdoors with this 9-hectare area which dominates the cliff and the sea. An unmissable place for the whole family and athletes with plenty of facilities available: A multi-sports ground with athletic tracks, football field, basketball boards and the chance to play tennis, volleyball, hockey, a BMX field, a sports area encompassing 19 workshops, a 16-lane bowling alley and 2 fishing lakes ... **Rue Edmond de Palézieux.**

Le Portel

PARC DE LA FALAISE

Imagine 27 hectares of green space divided into two sections: one for leisure activities, with a mini-golf course, walking trails, sports circuits, trail bike courses and a playground, and another left deliberately untouched to preserve its biodiversity. Donkeys, ponies, goats and sheep roam freely, taking care of the site's maintenance... In July and August, there are pony and horse and cart rides to delight children and adults alike. **Rue Jean-Paul Gachère.**



Nesles

PARC DE LA GLAISIÈRE

La Glaisière is a great example of how a former industrial wasteland can be rehabilitated. Exploited for many years as a clay quarry required by the cement manufacturing process, this site of more than 18 hectares has been returned to nature. The circuit of just over 1 km, will allow the whole family to discover the fauna and flora. **Rue de la Carrière.**

Outreau

PARC DU MONT SOLEIL

17 hectares of nature in the heart of the town with a panoramic view over the sea... What more could you want? Vast lawns, wild gardens, little ponds, majestic trees. It is always possible to find a quiet little corner to take a rest. There are plenty of summer activities for the family to enjoy. The mini-golf course (nine holes) is a great place for shared fun. NOTRE-DAME DE BOULOGNE BASILICA


Its dome can be seen from several kilometres away in every direction (101 metres in height)... Make no mistake, to visit the old town of Boulogne-sur-Mer without stopping at the basilica would be a capital offence !

Inspired by the Cathedrals of Saint-Paul's in London and Saint-Louis des Invalides, this colossal structure houses unexpected treasures : the Torlonia altar, composed of 147



varieties of marble and precious metals, the statue of King David, the great organ buffet, the Sacred Heart altarpiece, a chair of truth, frescoes and a crypt, unique in France, which alone is worth the detour.

Under the Notre-Dame Basilica stretches the largest crypt in France. A real labyrinth of 1 400 m² where some amazing pieces will leave you in awe. More than 400 items are resented along the tour :

silverware including the reliquary of the Saint-Sang offered to Notre-Dame by Philippe le Bel on the occasion of the marriage of his daughter, bas-relief pieces, stone sculptures of all eras, and paintings, including murals covering 4 000 m². The castle of the counts of Boulogne

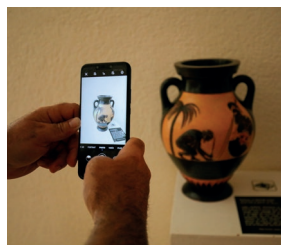
In the extension of the ramparts, the castle is the centerpiece of the fortress built by Count Philippe Hurepel in 1231. First object of all collections, it is also a gateway to the history of our city. The fortifications of the Roman city, are still visible today in the underground. The exhibition «The keys of the castle» invites you to discover the successive lives of this site, in turn, residence of the counts of Boulogne, military barracks, prison then museum since 1988.

LIBERTADOR SAN MARTIN MUSEUM

Some major characters have left their mark on the history of Boulogne-sur-Mer. Among them are : General Don Jose de San Martin who liberated Argentina from Spanish domination in 1816, followed by Chile in 1817 and Peru in 1821. Fleeing Paris and the revolutionary struggle, San Martin intended to go to England but the "charming little cobbled town" of Boulogne-sur-Mer appealed to him and he settled there with his family until his death in 1850. His house was transformed into a museum in 1928 and has become an authentic pilgrimage site for many Argentines.

THE BELFRY City Hall

Whether you want information or amazing sights, go to Place Godefroy de Bouillon in Boulogne-sur-Mer. Here presides proudly the city's oldest building ! The belfry is 47 metres high and has dominated the city since the 12th century.

It was given by Philippe Hurepel, Earl of Boulogne (and son of King Philippe Auguste !) to the bourgeois of the city and, like all belfries, it symbolizes communal liberties. Facing the monument one is surprised at how well it blends together with the city hall, which was built much later, in the 18th century. The use of brick and stone is a combination

of materials that is rarely found in Boulogne-sur-Mer... The two buildings alone demonstrate architectural methods used in the different eras throughout their history. Fascinating !

LE CALVAIRE DES MARINS

The view from the top of the cliff alone is worthy of a visit. As well as views over the port, the harbour and the Strait of the Pas de Calais, on a clear day it is also the best place to admire the English coast. But in high winds, the waves crashing against the dam makes for a spectacular sight too! The Roman Emperor Caligula had a lighthouse erected here, the Tower of Odre, which served to guide the navigation of boats in the strait. Falling victim to erosion, this tower collapsed in the seventeenth century.

And the collapsing cliff was also to get the better of the ancient Calvary of Sailors in the 1990s. When they came to rebuild it, the people of Boulogne, who were so attached to their old «Calvary», wanted to reuse the old materials. Located far back from the cliff, the building that stands today, complete with portholes, draws its inspiration from the maritime world and the bluish-coloured chapel represents the hull of a boat sinking into the sea. And since this building is dedicated to the memory of the people of Boulogne who perished at sea, 5600 names of missing sailors are engraved in the inner courtyard as well as a very long list of sunken ships.

SAINT-NICHOLAS CHURCH

The oldest church of Boulogne-sur-Mer stands on picturesque Place Dalton. It bears the name of the patron saint of the sea world: Saint-Nicholas. It was built in the 12th century, and reworked several times. The façade and 18th century nave, rearranged by Giroux Sannier, extend from a transept and choir which date back to the Gothic era. The church provides a charming backdrop to the market that takes place here every Wednesday and Saturday morning.

THE COLUMN OF THE GRANDE ARMÉE

This column represents a major historical fact and attracts thousands of visitors each year. Standing 53 metres high, the Column of the Grande Armée was built in Boulonnais marble and erected to the glory of Napoleon by the soldiers of Boulogne Camp. It is here, in Boulogne-sur-Mer that the Emperor summoned around 180,000 men to prepare for the invasion of England. At the site you can visit the Legion of Honour Park and Museum.

LEGION OF HONOUR STELE

A little story inside a great history ! You may not be aware that the Legion of Honour was established by Napoleon and there is a monument in Boulogne-sur-Mer which tells the story. Initiated on 19 May 1802, it is awarded for both military and civilian services. It was here in Boulogne-sur-Mer, on 16 August 1804, that the cross was awarded in the most grandiose ceremony ever to be held. The pyramid-shaped stele which commemorates the event is located at the very spot where Napoleon's throne stood.

NAPOLEONIC GUNPOWDER STORE

Perched on the cliff, the Gunpowder Store is another trace of the Great Army's presence in Boulogne-sur-Mer, just like the column erected to the glory of Napoleon and the Legion of Honour Stele. This amazing vestige which has survived the centuries cannot be visited but its position alone makes it worth the detour. Built in stone, it stored up to 120 barrels of gunpowder. You can enjoy examining the detail from the outside. The walls are pierced with ventilation slits, which were typical architectural features of powder stores. These slits were needed to fight against moisture which made the gunpowder useless.

CASTLE OF PONT-DE-BRIQUES

In 1803, when Napoleon set up his army of 180,000 men in Boulogne to invade England, the Château de Pont-de-Briques (hamlet of Saint-Léonard) was home to the headquarters. Napoleon dictated more than 300 letters there, held 8 councils of ministers. The First Consul stayed there for no less than 80 days (compared to 50 days in his palace in Compiègne!). The most significant decisions relating to Boulogne's camp and its conquest of the country of Albion were taken there. In August 1805, in Pont-de-Briques, Napoleon, under the pressure of events, took the momentous decision to abandon England's invasion to face the Austro-Russian coalition, which put an end to the Boulogne camp.



IMPERIAL PALACE

Located on the Place Godefroy de Bouillon, the Hotel Desandrouin has welcomed the Emperor three times. Three lightning passages were enough to rename this magnificent late 18th-century mansion into the «Imperial Palace.» Napoleon, then First Consul, stayed here for the first time in June 1803, then in 1810 in the company of Marie-Louise, and in 1811. Contrary to what one might imagine, Napoleon did not live in the Imperial Palace during the Boulogne camp. He had taken up residence at the Château du Pont de Briques. But the building nevertheless played a significant role as it served as the headquarters of the General Staff of the Grande Armée.



POINTE DE LA CRÈCHE

Arm yourself with patience and discover this jewel nestled in the cliffs' hollows between Boulogne-sur-mer and Wimereux. At high tide, you can admire the spectacle of the sea, the ballet of ships sailing through the Pas-de-Calais Strait, or, for the luckiest, the cliffs of our English neighbours. Sitting on the old blockhouses still frozen in the rock, the Pointe de la Creche is also a magnificent spot to admire the sunset. The first foundations of the fort date back to 1805, forming part of the Boulogne camp at the time of Emperor Napoleon.



HEURT FORT

Heurt Fort was built on the beach of Le Portel in 1803 to protect the Boulogne Camp against British attack. At low tide, fishermen engage in their favourite activity : mussel fishing. (Contact the Tourist Information Office to find out about current by-laws and where fishing is allowed.) This is the biggest natural mussel bed on the Opal Coast !

LA CRÈCHE FORT

Here you will learn about two centuries of history, from Napoleon to World War II. Constructed in a lush green setting that is now a protected natural site and property of the Conservatoire du Littoral, the Fort of the Crèche overlooks the bay of Boulogne-sur-Mer, the bay of Saint-Jean and Wimereux. Built in 1879, it is part of a vast coastal defence ensemble. Visits are organised by the manager of the site, the **Fort of the Crèche Association**.

ALPRECH FORT

Le Portel

If you love history and ancient stone, a visit of the Alprech Fort is a must ! At the foot of Le Portel lighthouse, this breathtaking site is waiting to be explored. Built between 1875 and 1880 by the Engineers under General Séré de Rivières, it housed bunkers which accommodated about a hundred men, as well as shops and gunpowder store. It was operational during the First World War, occupied by the German army from 1940 to 1944 and still bears some incredible scars. Perched on the heights of the town, the whole site offers panoramic views over the sea.

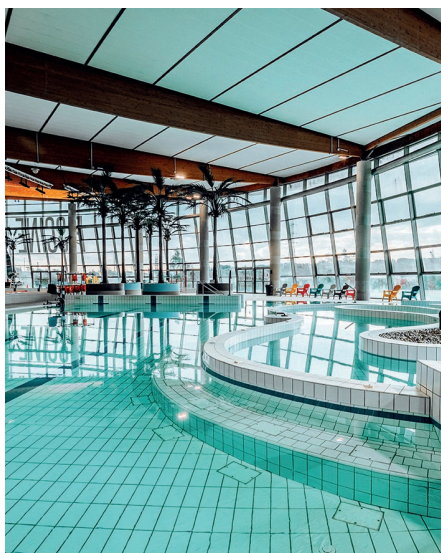

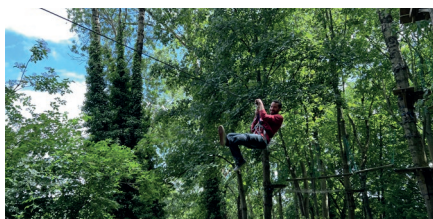
